Breed High Point Awards must have the Horse's Dam and Sire indicated on the entry form, and a copy of registration must be provided to be eligible for the award. Score must be 58% or better.

- The North American Danish Warmblood Association Trophy for the high score Danish.
- The American Trakehner Assoc Award for the high score Trakehner.

Entries: In-Hand & Under Saddle classes are \$35. Group Class is \$20/horse. No fee for Championship class. All entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for handler/rider, owner, and horse, a \$12 drug fee (\$7 Drug&Med fee, \$5 USEF fee), and non-refundable \$10 office fee. No entry accepted without a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show. Please include \$20 USEF non-member fee and/or \$5 discipline fee if applicable for non-Jrs. Checks payable to Centerline Events. Refunds, less office fee, made before closing date. A \$10 fee for changes after closing, or for incomplete entry. Non-negotiable check will be charged \$25. Post entries will be accepted with a \$20 post entry fee.

Unconditionally, no refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.

From I-95:

Take Exit 2 – Route 101 West. Take 1st exit off 101W Exit 12. Take a left off ramp, follow to end of road. Take a right on to Rte. 27. Go 1 mile turn left onto Rte. 88/Hampton Falls Rd. (@sign for Applecrest Orchard). Follow Rte. 88 for one mile; Liberty Farm will be on your right after the church. Go past Liberty Farm entrance. Entrance to Silver Oak Equestrian Center is on right after farm and another small house

From I-93:

Take Exit 7 - Route 101 East. Take Exit 11 Routes 108/88 Stratham/Exeter. Take right off ramp get immediately into left lane. Take 1st left (to Rte. 88) Holland Way. At stop sign take a right onto Rte. 27 and a quick left onto Rte. 88/Hampton Falls Rd. (@ sign for Applecrest Orchard). Follow Rte. 88 for one mile; Liberty Farm will be on your right after the church. Go past Liberty Farm entrance. Entrance to Silver Oak Equestrian Center is on right after farm and another small house

19. Grand Champion - open to Champion and Reserve from 7 & 18

Group Class

20. Produce of Dam - 2 or 3 offspring w/wo dam
21. Get of Sire - without sire, 2 or 3 of get
22. Breeder's Group - Group of two or three horses of any age or sex, all bred by the same exhibitor, and all must have shown in one in-hand class.

Amateur Handler – To be shown in-hand by an Amateur or Jr/YR with a current USEF Amateur card. Open to fillies/mares and geldings in any age group. No Stallions or colts except weanlings. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to the best of its ability.

23. Amateur Handler - Class will be divided as JR and AA if entries warrant.

Materiale Classes – Horses will be judged according to the criteria listed on the “USDF Materiale Score Sheet. Ages maybe combined if entries warrant.

24. Fillies - 3 year old
25. Colts/Geldings - 3 year old
26. Mares - 4 & 5 year old
27. Colts/Geldings - 4 & 5 year old

Under Saddle Classes – For classes 28 thru 32, entries shall be shown at the walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judging to be weighted 60% Movement, 30% Confirmation, 10% General impression.

28. Fillies - 3 years old (2002)

29. Colts/Geldings - 3 years old (2002)

30. Mares - 4 year & older

31. Stallion/Gelding - 4 year & older

32. Suitable to become a Dressage Horse - Entries must be at least 36 mos and no more than 7 years old, and cannot have competed above First Level.

33. Under Saddle Championship - open to 1st and 2nd place from 28 thru 32

34. Sport Pony in Hand – must have current measurement card

35. Sport Pony Under Saddle – must have a current measurement card
