

# East Coast Rider's Cup

The East Coast Rider's Cup, ECRC, was created in 1993 to promote recognition of the competitors and their mounts. By combining the two highest tests of the level, it shows a true champion who maintains that level of excellence through both rides.

## Awards:

There will be one Champion and one Reserve champion plus third thru sixth placings for each division, ie Training, First....The Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a ribbon and prize (TBA) at the required mounted award ceremony.

## Requirements:

1. Open to all competitors residing anywhere on the plant earth and open to horses of any breed sex, size or color.
2. Same horse/rider combination for both tests.
3. Tests must be ridden from memory
4. For Training through Fourth levels, the two highest tests of the level will be ridden, one each day. For the FEI levels, two tests of the same level will be ridden, ie two PSG or two Grand Prix, one each day. Both tests must be ridden to receive a score.
5. If six or more Adult Amateurs and/or JrYR compete, they will be separated from the Open division, and separate class awards will take place.
6. The placing will be determined by the combined total of the percentage score from both rides.
7. Ties will be broken on combined collective marks. If further tie breaker is needed, the score of the highest test of the level, then highest test collective marks. If still remained tie, then place remains tied and prizes will be combined and them split according to the USEF rules.
8. Champion and Reserve Champion must be available for mounted awards.
9. USEF Rules for riding the tests must be followed.
10. The same score for the highest test of the level may also be use as a qualifier for the USDF/GAIG Regional Championships with the correct fee to management. Please check prize list and note on entry form.
