Information for CDI Competitors:

A copy of the actual Definite schedule will be posted in the office and on the website, www.centerlineevents.com. It is also available to any FEI competitor prior to the show from the show secretary. See all applicable FEI regulations, specifically listed in the Omnibus.

- **Horse Passports are required.** Contact the USEF International Discipline Department.
- Vet Exam will start at noon on Thursday, upon arrival.
- Vet Inspection (Jog) will be held on Thursday at 5:00pm.
- When horse/rider have completed their CDI classes, they may enter open classes after their last FEI award ceremony.
- Ride Times will be determined by ranking and by draw. Please be familiar with FEI and CDI*** Rules/Regulations listed in the Definite Schedule.

Levels: Training through Grand Prix, and Freestyles. AA and Jr/YR classes offered at ECRC if entries warrant. 2012 GAIG/USDF Qualifying and Connecticut Freestyle Champion (CFC) Qualifying offered. Bluegrass Bear AA Challenge sponsored by Renee Isler, qualifying on Friday and Challenge on Sat and Sun. ECRC and AA Challenge rules are on www.centerlineevents.com.

Awards:

- 1) Six Ribbons and First Place Trophy for each open and pony class. Three ribbons each AA and Jr/YR in open classes.
- 2) For the Centerline Events CDI classes, a trophy for 1st place winner. Eight Ribbons will be presented in each class at the mandatory mounted award ceremony. For the small (pool of \$2000 min) and large (pool of \$4000 min) tours, stipend points will be awarded for each rider according to their placing and the number in the class. See Stipend Distribution online, www.centerlineevents.com.

- 3) **East Coast Riders Cup Champion and Reserve Champion** and ribbons to six places to the highest combined scores of the two rides for each division. Champion and Reserve Champion have mandatory mounted awards with prizes to be determined. Tests may be read. Whips are allowed.
- 4) **East Coast Pony Cup Champion and Reserve Champion** and ribbons to six places to the highest combined scores of the two rides for each division. Champion and Reserve Champion have mandatory mounted awards with prizes to be determined. Rider must ride both classes in level for championships, ie Training 2 and 3 and declare Adult (over 18) and Youth (18 and under). Championship will be divided between Adults and Youth if entries warrant. Tests may be read. Whips are allowed.
- 5) **Bluegrass Bear AA Challenge, sponsored by Renee Isler** – six ribbons, prizes and prize money to be distributed as follows: 1st place - \$250, 2nd place - \$150, and 3rd place - \$100 at each level Training thru 4th.
- 6) **Zeppa International Trophy** - Awarded to the best turned out horse and rider presented at the Vet Inspection. Formal award presentation will be made.
- 7) **Breed High Point Awards** must have the Horse's Dam and Sire indicated on the entry form, and a copy of registration must be provided to be eligible for the award. Score must be 58% or better. MFS or YH Tests do not count. See website for details, www.centerlineevents.com.
- 8) **Jamie Rudolph Memorial Award** – Highest Scoring Fourth Level and above with rider 18-28 yrs old. Score from Fri and Sat only. Please note eligible on your entry.
- 9) **Mitchell Retirement Farm Senior Horse Award** – For Horses 18 and older, score from Fri & Sat, level and age are considerations.
- 10) **Lynn Anger Award** – given to a groom whose horses and stabling areas are well maintained.
- 11) **Judith & Tom Noone High Score AA Award** - Highest Scoring AA in Training Test 2 (min score of 65%) and First Test 2 (min score of 63%). Sunday classes only. \$50 prize each class.

All entries **MUST** submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry/classes., a drug fee, and non-refundable office fee. No entry accepted without a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show. Please include USEF and/or USDF non-member fee if applicable. All entries must have three signatures including emergency info. Checks payable to **Centerline Events** or fill out Credit Card info on the entry form. Mastercard and Visa only. Entries can be mailed, faxed or emailed. Faxed or emailed entries are only accepted with CC as payment. Non-negotiable check or declined/ charge back credit card will be charged \$25. Post entries will be accepted to fill scratches with a \$50 post entry fee. Completed entries will be processed in the order they are received w/ exception of CDI entries. Riders may be limited to two classes/day (please specify) and will be notified if on the waiting list. Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less office fee. **Unconditionally, no refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition**, and will be considered a donation to the beneficiary. You may receive a receipt for your donation if requested in the show office.

Times: Times will be on the website, www.centerlineevents.com, at least one week prior to the competition.

Stabling: Permanent stalls 12'x12' (minimum) with full doors. CDI stabling fee is \$200. For open show, \$175 for duration. No initial bedding. Please note your stabling group on your entry. **No refunds on stabling after closing.** May arrive on Wednesday after 1 pm, must vacate by 7pm Sunday. Earlier arrivals and later departures must get permission from management and \$50/night fee. Non-CDI horses ridden by CDI riders may request to be stabled with their CDI horse at \$200 and non-CDI riders may request to stable their horse(s) with CDI horses at \$250. In both cases only if space permits and must have all the health/vaccinations certificates for FEI Vet Examination. Bedding (\$8 ordered by 8/12, \$10 at show) and Hay (\$15) available for purchase at the show office. Paddocks available for \$200.

Directions:

From the North: Take I-87 (NY State Thruway) to Exit 20 – Saugerties. Turn right on Rt 32 N

*Travel 0.5 mi past Peoples Rd to 'Y' intersection. Bear right at 'Y' intersection to County Rt 34 and go 0.1 mi to 4-way stop. Turn right onto Malden Turnpike/County Rt 34. Go 1.6 mi to stop sign at intersection for Rt 9W. Turn right onto Rt 9W South. Go 0.4 mi to Krout Rd. Turn right onto Krout Rd – Caution! This is a steep downhill grade. HITS will be on your left at the base of the hill. Turn in at Gate A.

From the South: Take I-87 (NY State Thruway) to Exit 20 – Saugerties. Turn left at traffic light after tollbooth.

Immediately move into the right lane and bear right onto Rt 32 North. Follow directions from '*'.

Footing: All classes are scheduled in large (20m X 60m) sand arenas. Five sand warm up arenas. Separate Lunging area. Separate sand warm up for CDI horses.

Entertainment: Food available on the grounds beginning 7am each day. Saturday evening gala dinner is \$35/person or \$250/table of 8. Includes hors d'oeuvre and dinner during the Freestyle. Beer and Wine may be purchased. Include payment with entry for reservation.

Other: Farrier on the grounds. Veterinarian on the grounds and on call, and contact info will be posted. All dogs must be leashed. Management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes. **EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**
