- USDF/Dover Adult Amateur medal is awarded to the high scoring Adult Amateur in class 123(Friday) and 223 (Saturday) USEF Second Level Test 3 that is a current USDF member who has score of 58% or higher.

Times: Times will be on the website, www.kingoakfarm.com, at least one week prior to the competition. Official times are posted noon of the day before the show. Please verify ride times at check-in.
