Information for CDI Competitors:

A copy of the actual Definite schedule will be posted in the office and on the website, www.centerlineevents.com. It is also available to any FEI competitor prior to the show from the show secretary.

Horse Passports are required. Contact the USEF International Discipline Department.

- Vet Exam will start at noon on Thursday, upon arrival.
- Vet Inspection (Jog) will be held on Thursday at 4:00pm.
- When horse/rider have completed their CDI classes, they may enter open classes after their last FEI award ceremony.
- Ride Times will be determined by draw. Please be familiar with FEI and CDI*** Rules/Regulations listed in the Definite Schedule.

GAIG If entering as Great American/USDF Qualifying, please so indicate on your entry form and include the \$10 Qualifying fee. Copies of USEF and USDF participating or business membership cards for both rider and owner, and copies of USEF Lifetime or Annual Horse Recording and the USDF full Lifetime Horse Registration must be included with entry.

BLM Results of this class will be used to qualify horse/rider combination for the 2011 Finals of the Colonel Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Championships. Riders must be members of a participating organization at the time of the show to be eligible.

Levels: Training through Grand Prix. AA and JrYR classes offered if entries warrant. 2011 GAIG/USDF/USEF and BLM Qualifying classes offered.

Awards:

- Trophy and six ribbons in each class. Trophy will be awarded only in classes with 3 or more entrants for each non-championship class.
- **USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal** will be awarded on Second Level Test 3 on Saturday.

- **Breed High Score Awards** will be offered. Please include breed registration papers for horse / owner / rider to be eligible. Participating breed organizations will be listed on website: www.centerlineevents.com and www.esdcta.org

- **THE ADULT AMATEUR HIGH SCORE CHALLENGE(AAC)** - Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an award and ribbons at each level Training thru Fourth and Prix St. Georges. A required mounted awards ceremony will take place on Saturday. The same scores from the two highest tests of the level may also be used as qualifying scores for the BLM or GAIG Championships with the appropriate qualifying fee (\$10).

Please note on the entry form next to the class name that you are entering the Adult Amateur High Score Challenge

Definition: The Adult Amateur High Score Challenge, created to promote the recognition of the adult amateur rider.

Conditions:

- 1- The Adult Amateur High Score Challenge is open to any and all USEF adult amateurs riding in Training level to Fourth level and Prix St. Georges who wish to enter.
- 2- Competitor rides the 2 highest tests of the level. The second highest test of the level is to be ridden on Friday, the highest test of the level is to be ridden on Saturday. The PSG on Saturday will be the qualifier for the AA High Score Challenge.
- 3- The percentage scores from the 2 qualifying rides will be averaged to determine the champion and reserve champion.
- 4- The two qualifying tests must be ridden by the same horse/rider combination in order for the scores to count.
- 5- The qualifying rides will be offered on Friday and Saturday with a mandatory mounted awards ceremony scheduled on Saturday. Please check award ceremony schedule posted at the show office.
- 6- Ties will be broken by the highest percentage score on the highest test of the level.
- 7- Further ties will be broken by the combined collective marks.
- 8- Additional ties will be broken by the decision of the judge.

All entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry, non-refundable office fee, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show, and payment. If not stabling, haul-in fee must be paid per horse per day. Please include USEF non-member fee or any other membership/horse registration fee(s) if applicable. All entry forms must have three signatures including emergency info. Make checks payable to **ESDCTA, Inc. ESDCTA’s volunteer bucks cannot be used for any part of show fees.** Do not send entries registered or signature required, as you will receive entry confirmation via email or by including SASE. Full refunds, minus the office fee, will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date. Partial refunds will be given after closing, minus the office fee, if ride times can be filled from the waiting list and on stabling if the stall can be re-rented. **No refunds after closing date or for ‘acts of god’ which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.** Non-negotiable check will be charged \$25. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted if space available with a \$50 post entry fee. Non-competing horses if space available, \$55 plus office fee.

Times: Times and stall assignments will be on the websites, www.esdcta.org and www.centerlineevents.com, at least one week prior to the competition. If you wish for your times to be sent, please include SASE.

Stabling: 276 permanent stalls with full doors (board on bottom and chain link fencing on top). No initial bedding provided. Use of straw bedding will incur a \$20/stall additional fee by the Horse Park unless competitor cleans stall. Earlier arrivals must get permission from management and \$50/night fee. Non-CDI horses ridden by CDI riders may request to be stabled with their CDI horse at \$180 and non-CDI riders may request to stable their horse(s) with CDI horses at \$225. In both cases only if space permits and must have all the health/vaccinations certificates for FEI Vet Examination. No refunds on stabling after closing.

Directions:

From NJ Turnpike and I-195East - Take Exit 7A to Route 195 East to Exit 11. Make a left to Route 524, then make a right. Horse Park is on the left, approximately 1 1/2 miles.

From the Garden State Parkway - Take Exit 98 to Route 195 West to Exit 11. Make a right to Route 524, then make a right. Horse Park is on the left, approximately 1 1/2 miles.

From Rt 537W (Freehold, NJ) – Rt 537W to Rt 524, Horse Park will be on right, (15 mins from center of Freehold).

Footing: Four stone dust arenas with stone dust warm up. If Indoor is used, footing is composite soil. Lunging only in designated area and time. Lunging times will be posted at the show office. Competition arenas are 20m x 60m or 20m x 40m.

Entertainment: Food available on the grounds beginning 7am each day. Competitor's Lunch on Saturday. Guest may attend the luncheon for \$10/ticket.

Other: Management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel any class.

Farrier on the grounds. Elden Klayman, DVM & Assoc., 732-780-7563 on grounds/on call. All dogs must be leashed. Unleashed dogs that are found are fined \$50 by the Horse Park. All Horses traveling into NJ must carry a Certificate of Good Health dated within 30 days of the competition.
