Unconditionally, no refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.

Times: Times will be posted on the website, www.tenbroeckfarm.net, during the week of the competition.

Stabling: Limited number of temporary stalls with full doors available at \$145 for duration. A stall cleaning deposit of \$25 on a separate check is required. Tack Stalls available only if space permits. No refunds on stabling after closing date (except for stall deposit). May arrive on Friday and must vacate by 7pm on Sunday.

20. Grand Champion - open to Champion and Reserve from 7 & 18

Group Class

21. Produce of Dam - 2 or 3 offspring w/wo dam
22. Get of Sire - without sire, 2 or 3 of get
23. Breeder's Group - Group of two or three horses of any age or sex, all bred by the same exhibitor, and all must have shown in one in-hand class.

Amateur & JrYR Handler – To be shown in-hand by an Amateur or Jr/YR with a current USEF Amateur card. Open to fillies/mares and geldings in any age group. No Stallions or colts except weanlings. To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to the best of its ability.

24. Amateur Handler - Class will be divided as JR and AA if entries warrant.

Materiale Classes – Horses will be judged according to the criteria listed on the “USDF Materiale Score Sheet. Ages maybe combined if entries warrant.

25. Fillies - 3 year old (2009)
26. Colts/Geldings - 3 year old (2009)
27. Mares - 4 & 5 year old
28. Colts/Geldings - 4 & 5 year old

Under Saddle Classes – For classes 29 thru 34, entries shall be shown at the walk/trot/canter both ways of the ring. Judging to be weighted 60% Movement, 30% Confirmation, 10% General impression.

29. Fillies - 3 years old (2009)

30. Colts/Geldings - 3 years old (2009)

31. Mares - 4 year & older

32. Stallion/Gelding - 4 year & older

33. Suitable to become a Dressage Horse - Entries must be at least 36 mos and no more than 7 years old, and cannot have competed above First Level.

34. Under Saddle Championship - open to 1st and 2nd place from 29 thru 33.

35. IBC Classes (each class must be sponsored \$200 to be able to be held) Held on Saturday only.
