Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less office fee. Post entries accepted if room allows.

Times: Times will be on the website, www.centerlineevents.com, at least one week prior to the competition.

Stabling: Limited number of temporary 10 x 10 stalls (120) with full doors available at \$150 for duration. No bedding provided, but shavings at \$8 can be purchased from WHC. Full Service night watch included. A stall cleaning deposit of \$25 on a separate check is required. Tack stalls available only if space permits. No refunds on stabling after closing date (except for stall deposit). May arrive on Friday afternoon, must vacate by 7pm Sunday.

From I-95: Take Exit 65 to Route 153. Travel North on Route 153 to McVeagh Road on left. Follow McVeagh Road to the end and turn left onto Pond Meadow Road. Westbrook Hunt Club is 1/8 mile up on your right.

From Route 9: Take Exit 3 to Route 153. Go Straight off Exit Ramp to second stop sign. Turn right onto Route 153 and go about 4 miles. Turn right onto McVeagh Road. Follow McVeagh Road to the end and turn left onto Pond Meadow Road. Westbrook Hunt Club is 1/8 mile up on your right.

Footing: Three sand arenas (20m x 60m) with sand warm up.

Entertainment: Food available on the grounds beginning 7am.
