A drug fee, a non-refundable office fee, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show date; and all entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry/classes. All horses must have documentation of EIV and EHV vaccinations according to GR845. Please include USEF Show Pass and/or USDF non-member fee if applicable. All entries must have three signatures including emergency info. Make checks payable to **R Folly Farm**. No Credit Cards accepted. Online entries accepted using [www.horshowoffice.com](http://www.horshowoffice.com) with 1.9% online entry fee. **Unconditionally, no refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.** Non-negotiable check will be charged \$25. Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less office fee. Any unused USEF or USDF fees will be refunded after any indebtedness is settled. Post entries will be accepted to fill scratches with a \$20 post entry fee.

**Times:** Times/Schedule will be on the website and [www.centerlineevents.com](http://www.centerlineevents.com), one week prior to the competition, and by noon the day before the show at the show office.

**Stabling:** Limited number of permanent stalls with full doors and 10'x10' min in the area. One night starting 4pm the day before to 4pm day of the show is \$75. Please call secretary for availability.

**Directions: From I-84** Take exit 7 Routes 7/202 East toward New Milford. When Route 7 and Route 202 separate, stay on Route 202 around the outskirts of New Milford toward Litchfield. Travel through Northville, New Preston, Woodville and past Mount Tom pond to West Morris Road. (West Morris Road is three miles past the intersection of Route 202 with Route 341.) Make a right and travel for 1.7 miles to R Folly Farm on the left.

**From Route 8 - north of Route 202** Take exit 43 Route 118 Litchfield. Stay on Route 118 and merge onto Route 202 in Litchfield. Travel west on Route 202 for 5 miles through Litchfield and Bantam to West Morris Road. Make a left and travel for 1.7 miles to R Folly Farm on the left.

**From Route 8 - south of Route 109** Take exit 35, Route 109/254. Stay on Route 109 for 9 miles to Stoddard Road. Make a right onto Stoddard Road and travel for .3 mile to Curtiss Hill Road. Make a slight left onto Curtiss Hill Road and continue straight where the road changes name to Burgess Road. Stay on Burgess Road to the stop sign at West Morris Road. Turn right onto West Morris Road and travel .1 mile to R Folly Farm on the right.

**Footing:** Footing is sand mixture for both warmup and competition arena. All tests ridden in 20x60.

**Entertainment:** No food available on the grounds except for water to purchase.

**Other:** Management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel any class. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Farrier on the grounds and on call.
