A drug fee, a non-refundable office fee, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show date; and all entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry/classes. All horses must have documentation of EIV and EHV vaccinations according to GR845. Please include USEF Show Pass and/or USDF non-member fee if applicable. All entries must have three signatures including emergency info. Make checks payable to **Centerline Events**. No Credit Cards accepted. Online entries accepted using [www.horseshowoffice.com](http://www.horseshowoffice.com) with 1.9% online entry fee.

**Unconditionally, no refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.** Non-negotiable check will be charged \$25. Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less office fee. Any unused USEF or USDF fees will be refunded after any indebtedness is settled. Post entries will be accepted to fill scratches with a \$20 post entry fee.

**Times:** Times/Schedule will be on the website and [www.centerlineevents.com](http://www.centerlineevents.com), one week prior to the competition, and by noon the day before the show at the show office. Times for sound checks will be posted at the office, and CDs must be in .MP3 or .WAV formats.

**Stabling:** Limited number of permanent stalls with full doors and 10'x10' min in the area. One night starting 4pm the day before to 4pm day of the show is \$75. Please call secretary for availability.

**Directions:** From I-84 : Take Exit 23, go South on Rt. 69 through Waterbury into Prospect. After the light at the intersection of Rt. 69 and Rt. 42, continue another 3.7 miles. Go to Bethway Rd and take a right. Go to the second driveway on the left.

From Rt. 8 : Take Exit 22, go East on Rt. 67 approx. 4.5 miles. At end of Rt. 67 take a right onto Rt. 63 South. Continue exactly 1.4 miles to left onto Clark Rd and follow to end. Take a left onto Rt. 69 North and go approx. 3.5 miles, turn left onto Bethway Rd and go to second driveway on left.

From I-95 : Take Exit 47, go North on Rt. 34 to Ella Grasso Blvd (Rt. 10) and turn right. Go to Whalley Ave, and turn left (Rt. 10) Rt. 10 will split to the right, but continue on Whalley Ave. Go through several lights until Rt. 69 bears to the right (see Mobil Station ahead and then bear right) Go under Rt. 15 and continue approx 5 miles. Turn left onto Bethway Rd. and go to second driveway on left.

From Merrit Pkwy (NO HORSE TRAILERS - passenger cars only!) : Take Exit 59. Travel North on Rt. 69 for approx. 5 miles. Turn left onto Bethway Rd. Second driveway on left.

**Footing:** New indoor with sand additive footing. Warm-up is in small indoor with Sand rubber footing or outdoor full size sand arena. All tests ridden in 20x60.

**Entertainment:** No food available on the grounds except for water to purchase.

**Other:** Management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel any class. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. Farrier on the grounds and on call.
